## DaySpring procedures to prevent the spread of Covid-19 and other infectious diseases.

## Below is a list of procedures that we will follow while your camper is with us.

\*Please note, these procedures may change based on recommendations from the CDC and American Camping Association\*



- Spring Heights staff are vaccinated against Covid-19.
- Organize camp into the smallest practical group sizes and keep groups consistent throughout the camp program.
- Holding activities outdoors as much as possible.
- Campers and staff will wear masks during all indoor activities, especially when maintaining physical distancing is not feasible due to area limitations.
- Ensure campers and staff practice proper hand hygiene: Instruct campers to wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds before and after activities.
- Provide alcohol-based hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol before and after activities.
- All shared items and equipment will be cleaned and disinfected between use.
- All outdoor equipment and facilities are routinely disinfected.
- Communal spaces are disinfected between small groups.
- Cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched surfaces and common spaces multiple times daily.
